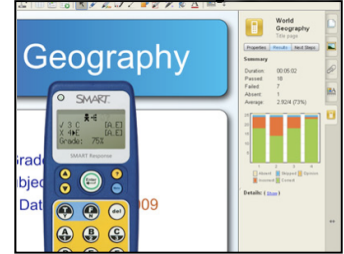


SMART Response



To import an assessment from a **WORD** document use this format:

To import an assessment from WORD

1. Select **Response > Import Questions From > Microsoft Word**
2. Browse to and select the document. Click **Open**.
3. In the *Page Sorter* view, select the thumbnail for the Title Page
4. Edit and customize the Title Page, as desired.
5. Check each question to verify that the conversion process was accurate.

To set the answers for questions imported from Word

1. In the *Page Sorter* view, select the first question page
2. Select **Response > Set All Answers** from the SMART Notebook menu bar
3. Type or select the correct answer from the options, and click **Done**
4. Select **File > Save**
5. Browse to destination folder, type a file name for the notebook file, and click **Save**.

To import an assessment from an XML file

NOTE: you must create an XML file formatted in Exam view before performing this procedure.
